What it is:

This is a scholarship in memory of Tekau Rasayon, awarded to a high school graduating senior that is going to college.

Who can apply:

A college-bound graduating senior from Maryland, the District of Columbia, or Virginia.

Requirements:

Submit an original, typed essay of about 500 words (no more than 650 words and no less than 250 words) on the following topic:

Tell us about a person who has influenced you in a significant way.

A copy of the college admissions acceptance letter of the school that you will be attending in the fall of 2022 **must be submitted** with the essay. No essays will be considered without this accompanying college admissions acceptance letter. The essay must include the student's name, and the name and address of the student's high school.

Submit your essay in one of the following ways:

- Postmarked no later than May 15, 2022 and mailed to Tekau's Heart Memorial Foundation, Inc., P.O. Box, 1953, Clinton, MD 20735
