What it is:

This is a scholarship in memory of Tekau Rasayon, awarded to a high school graduating senior that is going to college.

Who can apply:

A college-bound graduating senior from Maryland, the District of Columbia, or Virginia.

Requirements:

Submit an original, typed essay of about 500 words (no more than 650 words and no less than 250 words) on the following topic:

Tell us about a person who has influenced you in a significant way.

A copy of the college admissions acceptance letter of the school that you will be attending in the fall of 2023 **must be submitted** with the essay. No essays will be considered without this accompanying college admissions acceptance letter.

Submit your essay in one of the following ways:

- Electronically to the following email address no later than 11:59 pm, on April 15, 2023; tekausheart@gmail.com.
- Postmarked no later than April 15, 2023 and mailed to Tekau's Heart Memorial Foundation, Inc., P.O. Box, 1953, Clinton, MD 20735

Presentation/Announcement of the scholarship winner will be virtual, or at the winning students' High School Senior Awards ceremony. The scholarship winner, or a representative of the winner, must be present to receive the scholarship.
