

Tekau's Heart Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

What it is:

This is a scholarship in memory of Tekau Rasayon, awarded to a high school graduating senior that is going to college.

Who can apply:

A college-bound graduating senior from Maryland, the District of Columbia, or Virginia.

Requirements:

Submit an original, typed essay of about 500 words (no more than 650 words and no less than 250 words) on the following topic:

<u>Tell us about a person who has influenced you in a significant way.</u>

A copy of the college admissions acceptance letter of the school that you will be attending in the fall of 2024 **must be submitted** with the essay. No essays will be considered without this accompanying college admissions acceptance letter. It is also important to list the name and address of your high school on your essay.

Submit your essay in one of the following ways:

- Electronically to the following email address no later than 11:59 pm, on April 15, 2024; tekausheart@gmail.com.
- Postmarked no later than April 15, 2024 and mailed to Tekau's Heart Memorial Foundation, Inc., P.O. Box, 1953, Clinton, MD 20735

Presentation/Announcement of the scholarship winner will be virtual, or at the winning students' High School Senior Awards ceremony. The scholarship winner, or a representative of the winner, must be present to receive the scholarship.
